Franklin George Zaske, age 86, passed away peacefully at home on August 29, 2015. He will be deeply missed by his wife of 59 years, Marjorie, and his six children: George (Ann Iacarella) Zaske, Peter (Deborah) Zaske, Jean (Robert Whitlatch), Anne Zaske, Carol (William) Cole, Sarah (Garrett McElfresh) Zaske. He is also survived by nine devoted grandchildren - Josephine, Franklin, Anissa, Leo, Chloe, Aidan, Clara, Elsa, Matilda - and sister Virginia (William) Laing. He will also be missed by his many nieces, nephews, and friends.

Frank was born on November 19, 1928 in Portage, Wisconsin to Vernard and Della Zaske. He proudly served in the United States Army as a Staff Sergeant and combat medic during the Korean War (August 22, 1950 to August 21, 1953).
